USITT ANNUAL CONFERENCE Kansas City 2010

By the Hand of a Scenic LARGE FORMAT SCENE PAINTING EXHIBITION

Promoting scene painting examples from both students and professionals, the Annual USITT Conference in 2010 will include an exhibit of scene painting. Take advantage of the opportunity to show off the art and craft of scenic painting. Enter a favorite scene painting example so that the 4,000+ visitors expected at Stage Expo can view and enjoy.

Two exhibit formats will be available. The exhibit will include vertical panels where smaller pieces can be applied with pins/tacks of no more than 8' x 8'. The second portion of the exhibit will be hung from a pipe at the height of 12' running 72' along a wall of Stage Expo.

All exhibit pieces must be on soft goods (i.e., fabrics that can be hung with ties or tacks) and no more than 8' x 8' for the panels and no more than 11'6" high and 15' wide with ties for hanging in the pipe section.

A completed entrance form with a fee of \$30 must be sent to the USITT office no later than March 10, 2010.

Exhibit pieces may be sent to Kansas City, Missouri in advance of the opening of the event. Participants will be



sent an e-mail including the address where materials can be sent. The examples of scene painting can be sent starting March 1, and must arrive no later than March 26.

Those who have completed the application process and wish to deliver their work directly to the Kansas City Convention & Entertainment Facilities may do so at USITT's Stage Expo space on Monday, March 29 between the hours of 2 and 6 p.m. ONLY. (As the exhibit will be mounted on Tuesday, March 30, no submissions will be accepted at the Stage Expo space after the Monday deadline.)

All exhibit pieces must be picked up on Friday, April 2, 2010 between the hours of 4 and 7 p.m. If necessary, it may be possible to arrange special pickup on Saturday, April 3, 2010 between 8 a.m. and noon ONLY. NO material may be removed from Stage Expo before 4 p.m. on April 2.
